The Commission has the legal responsibility to formulate airport land use compatibility plans ("ALUCPs") that will (a) provide for the orderly growth of each public airport and the areas surrounding the airport within the County and (b) safeguard the general welfare of the inhabitants within the vicinity of each airport and the public in general. Pursuant to §21670.3, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority serves as the Commission.

Policy for Public Participation in Board, Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC), and Committee Meetings (Public Comment)

- 1) Persons wishing to address the Board, ALUC, and Committees shall complete a "Request to Speak" form prior to the initiation of the portion of the agenda containing the item to be addressed (e.g., Public Comment and General Items). Failure to complete a form shall not preclude testimony, if permission to address the Board is granted by the Chair.
- 2) The Public Comment Section at the beginning of the agenda is limited to eighteen (18) minutes and is reserved for persons wishing to address the Board, ALUC, and Committees on any matter for which another opportunity to speak is not provided on the Agenda, and on matters that are within the jurisdiction of the Board. A second Public Comment period is reserved for general public comment later in the meeting for those who could not be heard during the first Public Comment period.
- 3) Persons wishing to speak on specific items listed on the agenda will be afforded an opportunity to speak during the presentation of individual items. Persons wishing to speak on specific items should reserve their comments until the specific item is taken up by the Board, ALUC and Committees. Public comment on specific items is limited to twenty (20) minutes ten (10) minutes for those in favor and ten (10) minutes for those in opposition of an item. Each individual speaker will be allowed three (3) minutes, and applicants and groups will be allowed five (5) minutes.
- 4) If many persons have indicated a desire to address the Board, ALUC and Committees on the same issue, then the Chair may suggest that these persons consolidate their respective testimonies. Testimony by members of the public on any item shall be limited to **three (3) minutes per individual speaker and five (5) minutes for applicants, groups and referring jurisdictions.**
- 5) Pursuant to Authority Policy 1.33 (8), recognized groups must register with the Authority Clerk prior to the meeting.
- 6) After a public hearing or the public comment portion of the meeting has been closed, no person shall address the Board, ALUC, and Committees without first obtaining permission to do so.

Municipal Code Amendments for Reassignment of Decision-Making Authority on Capital Improvement Program Projects, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete & Consistent on December 12, 2013

<u>Description of Project</u>: The proposed project involves municipal code amendments to reassign decision-making authority on capital improvement program projects to streamline the process. It does not include any physical development.

<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and thus does not impact any noise exposure contours of any airport.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and thus does not impact any airspace protection surfaces of any airport.

<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and thus does not impact any safety zones of any airport.

Overflight Notification: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and thus does not impact any overflight notification area of any airport.

CONSISTENCY DETERMINATION SAN DIEGO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SDIA) AIRPORT LAND USE COMPATIBILITY PLAN (ALUCP) January 6, 2014

Recommendation: Conditionally Consistent

CONSTRUCTION OF A SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL UNIT AT 3142 STERNE STREET, CITY OF SAN DIEGO

<u>Description of Project</u>: Based on plans submitted to the ALUC, the project proposes the construction of a single-family residence on a property of 5,000 square feet. The application was deemed complete by ALUC staff on December 13, 2013. A similar project on the subject property with different interests was reviewed by the ALUC and found conditionally consistent with the ALUCP on January 5, 2006, but that project was never constructed and is being replaced by the proposed project.

Noise Contours: The proposed project is located within the 60-65 decibel Community Noise Equivalent Level (dB CNEL) noise contour. (See the attached map.) The ALUCP identifies residential uses located within the 60-65 dB CNEL noise contour as conditionally compatible with airport uses, provided that the residences are sound attenuated to 45 dB CNEL interior noise level. The ALUCP requires that an avigation easement for aircraft noise and height be recorded with the County Recorder. An avigation easement has been recorded over the subject property.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces:</u> The proposed project is located within the City of San Diego Airport Approach Overlay Zone (AAOZ). The maximum allowable height for a project on this site is approximately 300 feet Above Mean Sea Level (AMSL). The maximum elevation of the site is approximately 159 feet AMSL and the structure is another 27 feet, resulting in a total project height of approximately 186 feet AMSL. Therefore, the project complies with the AAOZ.

<u>Safety Zones:</u> The proposed project is located outside the Runway Protection Zones (RPZs).

Interests Disclosure: The property is owned by Mark Nichols of La Jolla. The architect is The Brown Studio of San Diego. The civil engineer is Christiensen Engineering and Surveying of San Diego. The landscape architect is McCullough Landscape Architecture of San Diego.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Based on review of the materials submitted in connection with the proposed project and the policies in the SDIA ALUCP, staff recommends that the ALUC make the determination that the project is conditionally consistent with the SDIA ALUCP.

Conditions: Sound attenuation to an interior noise level of 45 dB CNEL.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-0001 ALUC

A RESOLUTION OF THE AIRPORT LAND USE COMMISSION FOR SAN DIEGO COUNTY, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2006-0006 ALUC AND MAKING A DETERMINATION THAT THE PROPOSED PROJECT: CONSTRUCTION OF A SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL UNIT AT 3142 STERNE STREET, CITY OF SAN DIEGO, IS CONDITIONALLY CONSISTENT WITH THE SAN DIEGO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT - AIRPORT LAND USE COMPATIBILITY PLAN

WHEREAS, the Board of the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority, acting in its capacity as the Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) for San Diego County, pursuant to Section 21670.3 of the Public Utilities Code, was requested by the City of San Diego to determine the consistency of a proposed development project: Construction of a Single-Family Residential Unit at 3142 Sterne Street, City of San Diego, which is located within the Airport Influence Area (AIA) for the San Diego International Airport (SDIA) Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP), originally adopted in 1992 and amended in 1994 and 2004; and

WHEREAS, the plans submitted to the ALUC for the proposed project indicate that it would involve the construction of a single-family residential unit; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project would be located within the 60-65 decibel (dB) Community Noise Equivalent Level (CNEL) noise contour, and the ALUCP identifies residential uses located within the 60-65 dB CNEL noise contour as compatible with airport uses, provided that the residences are sound attenuated to 45 dB CNEL interior noise level, and that an avigation easement is recorded with the County Recorder; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is in compliance with the Airport Approach Overlay Zone (AAOZ) height restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is located outside the Runway Protection Zones (RPZs); and

WHEREAS, the ALUC has considered the information provided by staff, including information in the staff report and other relevant material regarding the project; and

WHEREAS, the ALUC desires to rescind Resolution No. 2006-0006 ALUC because the determination of consistency therein was for a project not constructed and is being replaced by the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the ALUC has provided an opportunity for the City of San Diego and interested members of the public to present information regarding this matter:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the ALUC hereby rescinds Resolution No. 2006-0006 ALUC and determines that the proposed project: Construction of a Single-Family Residential Unit at 3142 Sterne Street, City of San Diego, is conditionally consistent with the SDIA ALUCP, which was originally adopted in 1992 and amended in 1994 and 2004, based upon the following facts and findings:

- (1) The proposed project involves the construction of a single-family residential unit.
- (2) The proposed project is located within the 60-65 dB CNEL noise contour. The ALUCP identifies residential uses located within the 60-65 dB CNEL noise contour as compatible with airport uses, provided that the residences are sound attenuated to 45 dB CNEL interior noise level and that an avigation easement is recorded with the County Recorder. An avigation easement has been recorded over the subject property. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, the structure must be sound attenuated to 45 dB CNEL interior noise level.
- (3) The proposed project is located within the AAOZ. The maximum allowable height for a project on this site is approximately 300 feet Above Mean Sea Level (AMSL). The maximum height of the proposed project is approximately 186 feet AMSL. The proposed project is therefore in compliance with the height limitations identified in the SDIA ALUCP.
- (4) The proposed project is located outside the RPZs.
- (5) Therefore, if the proposed project contains the above-required condition, the proposed project would be consistent with the SDIA ALUCP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this ALUC determination is not a "project" as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Pub. Res. Code Section 21065, and is not a "development" as defined by the California Coastal Act, Pub. Res. Code Section 30106.
