Meeting Date: **DECEMBER 1, 2011** Subject: **Authorize the Rejection of the Claim of Paula Tate Recommendation:** Adopt Resolution No. 2011-0144, authorizing the Rejection of the Claim of Paula Tate. **Background/Justification:** On October 4, 2011, Paula Tate ("Tate") filed a claim with the Authority alleging that on October 7, 2011, she fell as she rode an escalator at San Diego International Airport. Tate claims cruise fare and loss of wages as damages in the amount of five thousand (\$5000) dollars. Tate alleges in her claim that on October 7, 2011, she fell as she rode an escalator after arriving by air from Sacramento. She states she placed her carry-on bag on the escalator step and it knocked her carry-on towards her, causing her to fall. She alleges the fall resulted in a broken foot and two bruised fingers. Tate's claim should be denied. An investigation into the incident revealed no unsafe condition of public property nor any notice of an unsafe or dangerous condition, nor is a dangerous condition alleged. I am writing this letter to your company for San Diego airport. I came in October 7, 2011 on Southwest airlines. 1254 flight from Sacramento. My husband and I were headed to a cruise on Saturday, but did not make it because of a injury I received at your airport, I spend from 4PM to 10:30PM Scripps Mercy Hospital in San Diego. Had to turn around on Saturday and go home to Sacramento airport with Southwest.

I contacted Southwest with this situation, they said they lease a place at your airport. We picked up our luggage, headed to your escalator where I was injured and broke my left foot in two places. Bruises two fingers on my right hand.

I have had the expenses of: \$3,000.00 for cruise package \$2,000.00 lost of wages Total for loss is \$5,000.00

I have been using my private medical insurance for my health bills. We do have co pays, I am alright with using out medical insurance. At this time. But we are devasted to have missed our trip because of your escalator.

I was on escalator with my small carry on when something happened with carryon and your escalator which stuck and knocked me down. It happened so fast I wasn't sure where I was hurt until later knew foot hurt but was praying it was not serious. This was a brand new carry on, I had to start yelling help before someone came and turned escalator off. He did not ask if I was okay only scolded me for not taking elevator with my small carry on.

I do not want to drag an attorney on this, but would like a response if you need receipts of our loss would be happy to send to you. I am planning to go back to work December 1st, 2011. but have had no income since this accident. I would like a response to this letter and if this is not where it is to be, please forward to correct office.
