AGENDA & SUMMARY

Item 1 – Introductions, Oris Dunham, Chair of RASP Subcommittee

Item 2 – Alternative Scenarios Presentation, Jacobs Consultancy

Question was raised about evaluation of scenarios in demand model including criteria, weighting, prioritizing, and ability to implement

Chair/Vice Chair said study will show demand, how best to meet it regionally, and which outcomes make the most sense

Consultant Team said the study evaluates aggregate capacity throughout network with the goal to optimize surface and aviation capacities to the base forecast assuming certain constraints and investments

Clarification was requested on specific airport improvements and operation requirements necessary for Brown Field to support commercial service. Appreciation was expressed for incorporation of previous comments regarding Brown Field.

Concern was expressed about the importance of quantifying study benefits because some could be skewed and marginal

Consultant Team said no weighting or recommendations will be given in the model. Decision makers will evaluate the model output and decide which airport improvements should be selected.

Clarification was made that wingspan is a factor along with runway length in determining aircraft use feasibility at McClellan-Palomar Airport

Concern was expressed about effect on system of driving away recreational general aviation if creating high-end corporate aviation is a change at existing general aviation airports

Questions were asked about high speed rail frequency and charge for using cross-border facility; neither have been determined

Clarification was made that cross-border facility would likely not be operational till 2012, with SANDAG coordinating surface access; dual border terminal operation characteristics were identified

Question was raised about measure of success of subcommittee and consultant team's work; consultant team indicated scenario effectiveness would be considered by decision-makers
