History of the Luggage Label

Luggage labels and stickers were first created by hotels and steamship lines as a way to link luggage with their owners' transportation and hotels. Labels were first used in the late 1800s during the Industrial Revolution, a time when the use of machinery helped build towns and improve lifestyles, opening up travel to new groups of people.

Luggage labels became fashionable objects that helped identify well traveled folks. Very



early designs used only symbols and words, and were made mostly by hotels and steamships. Later, labels featured coat of arms/family designs, animals, attractions, people, and other forms of transportation like airplanes.

Although not used much in travel today, vintage label collecting is a popular hobby.
