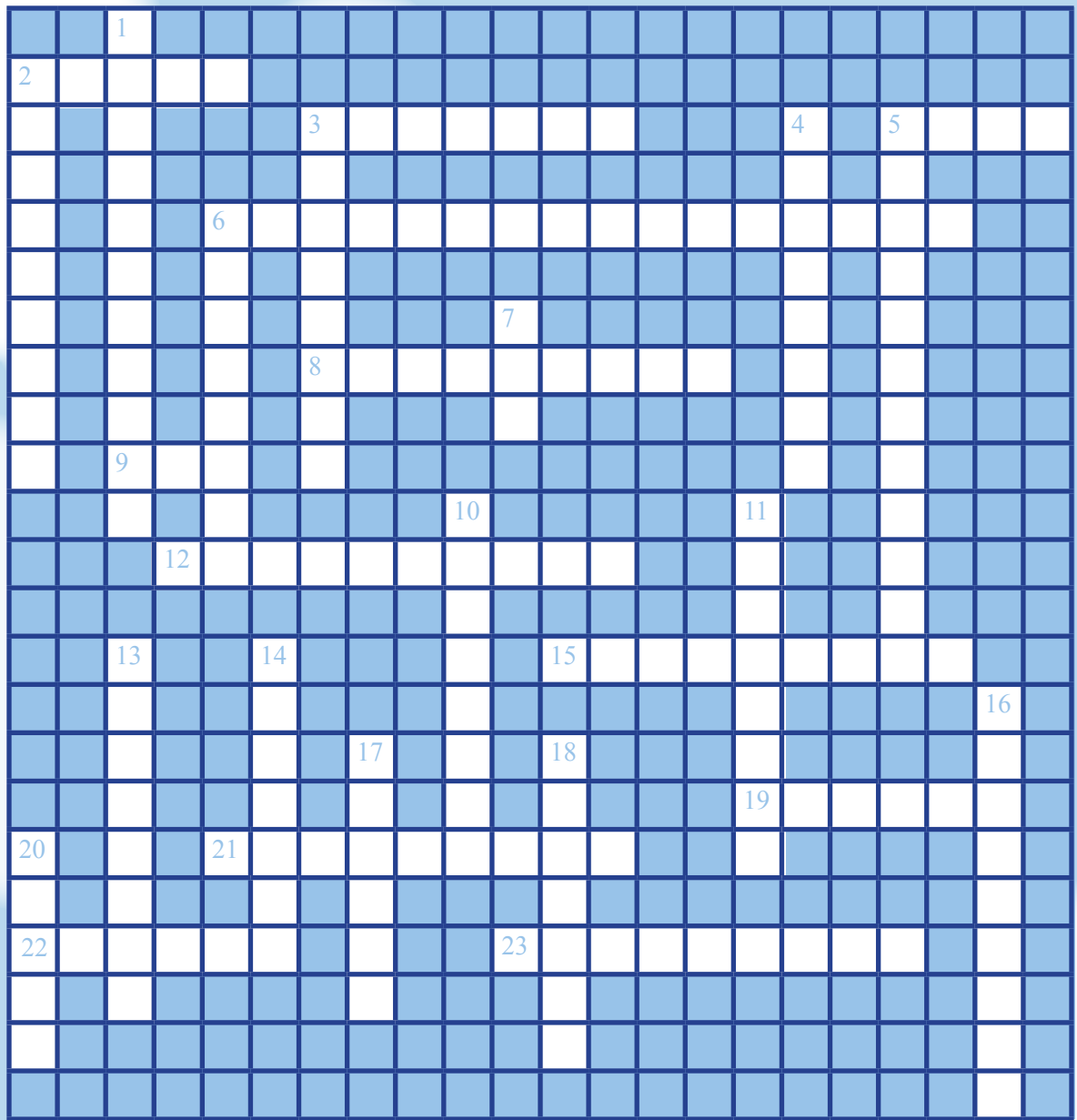


SkyWORD Puzzle

1. Early pilot who did stunts and gave airplane rides
2. Describes aircraft with wings permanently attached to fuselage, not like helicopter rotors (2 words)
3. How fast an aircraft is moving compared to its surrounding air mass
4. Device used for flight in the air
5. Flight on which passengers do not have to change planes, but may involve one or more stops (2 words)
6. Engine-driven fixed-wing aircraft
7. When piloting a plane, to turn to the left or right
10. Main body of an airplane
11. Position of aircraft based on a certain point, like the horizon or direction of motion
13. Hinged flaps on wings that control a banked turn
14. Downward pull on an object
16. Airplane instrument that senses air pressure
17. Vehicle at San Diego International Airport that transports between the terminals (2 words)
18. Record of a pilot's training and flying achievements
20. Special airfield area where airplanes unload, fuel and park

22. Surface of area on the airfield designated for takeoff and landings of airplanes
23. Condensation trails or vapor trails made by the exhaust of a jet aircraft
