Regulation of Expressive Activities Amendment at San Diego International Airport

EXHIBIT "B"

GENERAL

San Diego International Airport, owned and operated by the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority, is a large hub commercial service airport dedicated to providing air transportation services to the San Diego region. In that the Airport provides an interesting and exciting venue for expressive activities, it is necessary to establish parameters for its use for expressive activities.

EXPRESSIVE ACTIVITIES - PROVISIONS

1. Any person(s) or organization desiring to use the San Diego International Airport (Airport) for the purpose of solicitation or other expressive activities in an asserted exercise of freedoms of speech, assembly, or religion shall be permitted to engage in such activities provided that such activities are in compliance with the provisions set forth below.

In accordance with the provisions of Article 8, Part 8.4. Section 8.40 of the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority Code, the following activities are restricted outside the Terminal buildings at designated locations and require the issuance of an Expressive Activities Permit before they may be conducted on Airport property.

- A. Soliciting and receiving alms.
- B. Soliciting and receiving funds.
- C. Conducting surveys or soliciting information from the general public.



- D. Conducting or participating in any parading, picketing, marching, patrolling, demonstrating, and/or assembling.
 - E. Seeking petition signatures.
2. The following activities are allowed inside the Terminal buildings at designated locations and require the issuance of an Expressive Activities Permit before they may be conducted on Airport property.
- A. Conducting or participating in any speech making and/or proselytizing.
 - B. Carrying, displaying, or causing to be displayed any signs or placards.
 - C. Distributing any literature, pamphlets, or other printed material.

EXPRESSIVE ACTIVITIES - APPLICATION SUBMITTAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Airport Operations Department – Landside Operations at San Diego International Airport will process all Expressive Activities Applications and issue Expressive Activities Permit Authorizations for all related activities conducted on Airport property.

- 1. Please read all Expressive Activities Application documents thoroughly.
- 2. Complete and submit the Expressive Activities Application form in its entirety.

The Airport Operations Department, Landside Operations Section is located at San Diego International Airport in the Commuter Terminal, Third Floor. Operating hours is Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; closed holidays.



EXPRESSIVE ACTIVITIES - AUTHORIZATION PROCEDURES

1. The Expressive Activities Permit Authorization process begins with the submission of a completed Expressive Activities Permit Application to the Airport Operations Department – Landside Operations representative. Applications will be processed within two (2) business days from date of receipt.
 - A. The representative, on behalf of the Executive Director/President, shall issue an approved permit within two (2) business days, unless a prior permit for the same time period has been issued and the activities authorized by that permit do not reasonably allow multiple occupancy of the available areas. No permit shall be denied on the basis of content.
 - B. A limited number of permits may be issued at any one time due to the highly congested areas adjacent to the Terminals and limited operational space. Permittees will be restricted to the designated areas (see attached map of locations). Occupancy of a particular area is on a first come, first served basis. Permittees will be restricted to the designated areas as shown on the attached map.

NOTE: The issuance of a Permit does not guarantee an Applicant space on Airport property to conduct Expressive Speech Activities. When available space is exhausted, the conduct of Expressive Speech may be curtailed.
 - C. When the Executive Director/President, receives more applications for permits than he or she is able to grant in accordance with the foregoing, then he or she may impose such other reasonable and equitable restrictions as to allowable dates or hours or numbers of participants as may reasonably required to provide fair opportunities as equally as possible for all applicants, while ensuring the effective and efficient operation of the Airport.
 - D. Under normal circumstances, Expressive Activities Permits are valid for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of issuance for purpose of solicitation activities described in paragraphs 1, 2, and 3, and seven (7) days from the date of issuance for the purpose of activities described in paragraphs 4, 5, and 6.

EXPRESSIVE ACTIVITIES - LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

This application is subject to the following rules and regulations:

1. No participant shall commence expressive activities at the Airport without a signed Expressive Activities Permit issued under the authority of the Executive Director/President or his/her authorized representative.
2. The Group Representative or Contact Person must have the Expressive Activities Permit Application in their possession at all times during the event.
3. Activities covered in this regulation are confined to the designated areas shown on the attached diagram. No activities of the nature described herein are permitted in any other location on the Airport property.
4. No sound amplification of any type shall be permitted. The Applicant or Sponsoring Organization shall comply with all noise regulations of the City of San Diego.
5. No bags, containers, written materials or other personal property shall be left unattended in any area of the Airport.
6. Any litter generated in or about the designated area shall be immediately removed from the area by the group prior to their departure from the Airport. Failure to comply may result in the Airport billing the sponsoring organization for related janitorial expenses.
7. No improvements or modifications may be made or equipment installed. Any damage resulting from the expressive activity shall be repaired at the expense of the Applicant or Sponsoring Organization.
8. No participant shall impede, inhibit or otherwise block access or obstruct the orderly movement of pedestrian or vehicular traffic at any time.
9. No participant may approach any person who is entering or exiting a curbside vehicle; or any person seated inside a curbside vehicle.
10. A participant shall immediately cease all activities directed at any individual, where such individual has indicated his/her unwillingness to listen to the person or accept any handbill, flower or other object proffered by the participant.



11. A participant shall not falsely or fraudulently represent that he or she is a member of any organization other than the one, which is stated in the application.
12. As a condition for issuance of the permit, the Sponsoring Organization shall indemnify and hold harmless the San Diego Unified Port District from any and all claims, demands, suits, actions or proceedings of any kind or nature, including workers compensation claims, of or by anyone in any way resulting from any act or omission of the Sponsoring Organization or such officers, agents, participants, or employees of the Sponsoring Organization.
13. The Executive Director/President, or his/her authorized representative shall revoke a permit for a violation of any of the provisions listed in this instruction. When a Sponsoring Activity or participant is notified of the revocation they must cease all activities described herein. Failure to comply with instructions will constitute a misdemeanor.
14. Any person or Sponsoring Organization whose application for a permit is denied or whose permit is revoked may appeal to the Executive Director/President of the Authority within ten (10) days of the denial or revocation. The appeal must be in writing. The Executive Director/President will respond within ten (10) days of receipt of the appeal. If the appeal to the Executive Director/President is denied, the person or Sponsoring Organization may appeal, in writing, to the Board Members of the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority within ten (10) days of the denial. Upon filing of said appeal with the Authority Clerk of the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority, an Applicant and/or Sponsoring Organization may not resume regulated activities until final determination of the appeal by the Board Members of the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority. All decisions of the Board of the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority are final.
