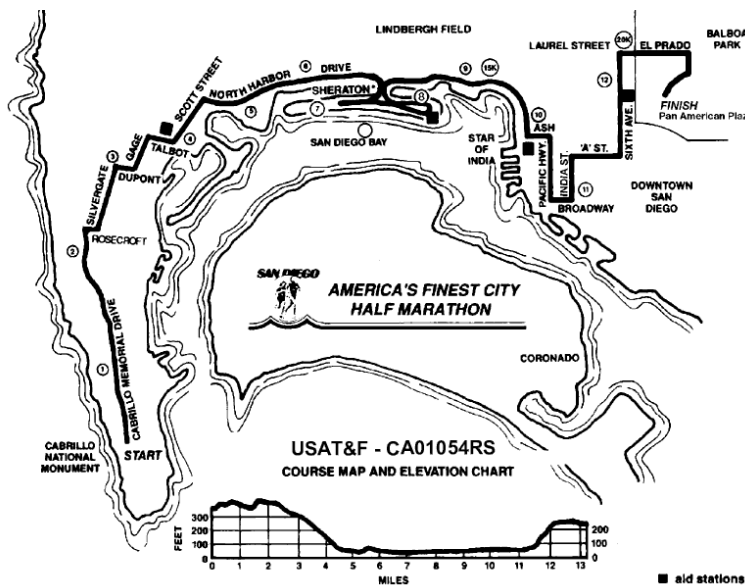

San Diego Half Marathon may affect airport traffic

SAN DIEGO – August 11, 2010 – Users of San Diego International Airport may experience delays in and around the airport roadways on Sunday, August 15, due to the 33rd Annual America's Finest City Half Marathon. The race will begin at 7:00am at the Cabrillo National Monument, continue along North Harbor Drive, around Harbor Island and end in Balboa Park.

Event planners have confirmed that two lanes in both directions of North Harbor Drive will be open at all times, but with almost 8,000 runners participating in this event, there may be intermittent road slowing between 6:45am and 10:00am. See the map below for the course route.
