## Newest public art installation dedication at Commuter Terminal

*“Time Interwoven” represents 24 time zones of the world*



**What:** The Airport Authority will host a reception to honor the latest public art installation, “Time Interwoven,” by local artist Christie Beniston. This is the first permanent art installation under the Airport Authority Art Master Plan. The artwork is installed in the elevator lobby of the Commuter Terminal. A metaphor for time and travel, the piece is divided into 24 color panels, representing the 24 longitudinal zones of the world. Each panel contains the name of a city in that particular time zone.
