Airlines at San Diego International Airport announce service enhancements for spring/summer 2009 travel

SAN DIEGO — February 3, 2009 — American Airlines, Air Canada, AirTran Airways and WestJet Canada are all announcing major service enhancements from San Diego International Airport – just in time for the upcoming spring and summer travel season.



American Airlines®

American Airlines will resume summer seasonal service to **Boston, Massachusetts**, on April 7, 2009. The American flight will be San Diego's second nonstop to Boston, augmenting service currently offered by JetBlue Airways. The flight will operate daily with Boeing 757s configured with 22 first class and 166 coach seats:

AIR CANADA

Air Canada will begin daily service between San Diego and **Calgary, Alberta**, on May 15, 2009. This new international nonstop route will use CRJ-705 aircraft configured with 10 executive class and 65 economy class seats. All seats are equipped with Air Canada's in-flight personal TVs:

AirTran Airways will resume summer service to San Diego on May 5, 2009, with a daily flight to and from **Atlanta**. On May 21, 2009, this will increase to two daily flights between San Diego and Atlanta, and the airline will also add the first nonstop flight between San Diego and **Milwaukee, Wisconsin**. All AirTran flights will use Boeing 737 aircraft with 12 business class and 125 coach class seats, each equipped with XM Satellite radio:

WestJet Canada, a new international airline coming to San Diego, will arrive on June 1, 2009. WestJet plans to offer seasonal thrice-weekly nonstop service to **Calgary, Alberta**, with all-economy 136-seat Boeing 737s. Every WestJet seat is equipped with Bell Canada satellite television.
