A dance performance at the airport starring ... luggage?

Unique free performance August 18 by the San Diego Dance Theater



SAN DIEGO – August 17, 2009 – Get ready to see luggage like you've never seen it before. On Tuesday, August 18, 2009 from 11:00am -1:00pm, San Diego International Airport's Performing Arts Program – known as [à brève](#) – will present a free improvisational performance of *Rolling Luggage* by the San Diego Dance Theater in, appropriately enough, the airport's Terminal 2 West baggage claim area.

Rolling Luggage is the work of acclaimed choreographer Jean Isaacs, known for creating Trolley Dances as an innovative way to reach a larger audience by using mass transit to introduce site-specific choreography to the public. Tomorrow's performance at the airport will depict eight apparent travelers who, after claiming their luggage, begin to spin, swivel and “rock out” to music in the air.
