This meeting of the Airport Land use Commission will be conducted pursuant to the provisions of California Assembly Bill 361 which suspends certain requirements of the Ralph M. Brown Act. On December 20, 2021, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority Board adopted Resolution Number 2021-0147 finding that as a result of the continuing State of Emergency and the fact that local officials have recommended measures to promote social distancing and a finding that meeting in person continues to present imminent risks to the health and safety of attendees, it is in the best interest of the Authority and the public to continue to conduct meetings of the Airport Land Use Commission virtually pursuant to AB 361. Therefore, in the interest of public health, all Board and Committee Members will be participating in the meeting electronically. In accordance with Assembly Bill 361 and Authority Board Resolution No. 2021-0147, there will be no members of the public in attendance at the Commission Meeting. - 2) The Public Comment Section at the beginning of the agenda is reserved for persons wishing to address the Board, ALUC, and Committees on any matter for which another opportunity to speak is not provided on the Agenda, and on matters that are within the jurisdiction of the Board.
- 3) Persons wishing to speak on specific items listed on the agenda will be afforded an opportunity to speak during the presentation of individual items. Persons wishing to speak on specific items should reserve their comments until the specific item is taken up by the Board, ALUC and Committees.

Airport Land Use Commission Staff Report

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Report of Determinations of Consistency with Airport Land Use Compatibility Plans

Pursuant to Airport Authority Policy 8.30, and acting in its delegated capacity as the Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) for San Diego County, Airport Authority staff has issued the following consistency determinations per their respective ALUCPs:

Naval Air Station North Island and San Diego International Airport ALUCPs:

Update to the Barrio Logan Community Plan with Rezones, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete and Conditionally Consistent on December 13, 2021

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project involves a comprehensive update to the Barrio Logan Community Plan and associated rezones of properties within the community plan area. The plan provides goals and objectives regarding multiple policy areas, including consistency with the ALUCPs. No physical development is proposed by the project.

<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project lies outside the 60 decibel Community Noise Equivalent Level (dB CNEL) noise exposure contour of both the NASNI and SDIA ALUCPs. The NASNI and SDIA ALUCPs identify all uses located outside the 60 dB CNEL noise contour as compatible with airport uses.

Airspace Protection Surfaces: The proposed project lies within the airspace protection boundaries of both the NASNI and SDIA ALUCPs. Future construction of structures and objects within the project area are subject to requirements for notice and review by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) or, alternatively, the sponsor of such construction must certify that notice and review is not required by the FAA because the structure or object is located within an urbanized area, is substantially shielded by existing structures or natural terrain, and cannot reasonably have an adverse effect on air navigation. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, notice of future construction of structures and objects within the project area must be provided to the FAA, with a Determination of No Hazard to Air Navigation secured from the same and conditions in said determination adhered to for marking/lighting, or the project sponsor must certify that notice to the FAA is not required if the structure or object meets the aforesaid attributes.

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<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project is located outside all safety zones of both the NASNI and SDIA ALUCPs.

Overflight Notification: The proposed project is located within the overflight notification area of the SDIA ALUCP. The SDIA ALUCP requires that a means of overflight notification be provided for new residential land uses. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, new residences of the project located within the overflight notification area of the SDIA ALUCP must receive a means of overflight notification per the ALUCP.

Brown Field Municipal Airport, Gillespie Field, Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, Montgomery-Gibbs Executive Airport, Naval Air Station North Island, Naval Outlying Landing Field Imperial Beach, and San Diego International Airport ALUCPs:

Amendment to City Land Development Code for Spaces as Places Program, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete and Consistent on December 7, 2021

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project proposes an amendment to the city land development code for requirements related to the Spaces as Places program. This program provides provisions to transition temporary outdoor spaces, used to replace indoor capacity in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, to permanent outdoor spaces utilized by adjacent businesses such as restaurants. No actual development is proposed.

<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and, thus, does not impact any airport noise contours. Future improvements under this project would be subject to noise compatibility standards of the applicable ALUCP(s).

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and, thus, does not impact any airspace protection surfaces. Future improvements under this project would be subject to airspace compatibility standards of the applicable ALUCP(s).

<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and, thus, does not impact any safety zones. Future improvements under this project would be subject to safety compatibility standards of the applicable ALUCP(s).

<u>Overflight Notification</u>: The proposed project does not involve any residential development and, thus, is not subject to any overflight notification requirements.

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Minimum Parking Requirement Amendments to Municipal Code, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete and Consistent on December 10, 2021

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project proposes amendments to the municipal code to eliminate minimum parking requirements for a majority of nonresidential uses within transit priority areas and neighborhood serving commercial land uses. No physical development is proposed by the project.

<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and, thus, does not impact any airport noise contours. Parking facilities are compatible within all airport noise contours.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and, thus, does not impact any airspace protection boundaries. Future parking facilities would be subject to requirements for notification and review by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) if meeting notice criteria, or the project sponsor must certify that no FAA notice is required.

<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project does not involve any actual development and, thus, does not impact any safety zones. Parking facilities are compatible within all airport safety zones except Safety Zone 1 or the Clear Zone.

<u>Overflight Notification</u>: The proposed project does not involve any new residential development and, thus, does not impact any ALUCP overflight notification requirements.
