









## AIR SERVICE TREND: INTERNATIONAL GROWTH Change in Available Seat Miles (ASM) (Indexed to YE 2004 = 100)


#### FUTURE FACTORS AFFECTING AIR SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

- New technology (Boeing 787) makes long-thin routes viable even with current fuel prices
  - San Diego's airport will be more international
  - Departure environment will still limit range from SAN
- "Open-skies" agreements have created open air service markets to most regions of the world (exceptions: China, Mexico, and Brazil)
- Visa-policy / visa-waiver: Korea and maybe future Taiwan and Argentina, more efficient visa processing needed for "BRIC" countries (center of aviation growth worldwide)
- Domestically
  - Legacy carriers focus on hubs (limited point to point opportunities)
  - Niche carriers willing to operate seasonal or less than daily services (will need airport flexibility)
  - Air Service targets will focus on airlines with growth aircraft
