Adopt Resolution No. 2011-0136, approving and authorizing the President/CEO to execute a Second Amendment to the agreement with Kleinfelder West, Inc., extending the term of the agreement by one year to expire on December 31, 2012, to provide on-call professional material testing, special inspection, and geotechnical services for Capital Improvement Projects.

Adopt Resolution No. 2011-0138, approving and authorizing the President/CEO to execute a Second Amendment to the agreement with Ninyo & Moore Geotechnical & Environmental Sciences Consultants, extending the term of the agreement by one year to expire on December 31, 2012, to provide on-call professional material testing, special inspection, and geotechnical services for Capital Improvement Projects.

Background/Justification:

The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority ("Authority") currently has agreements with Kleinfelder West, Inc., MACTEC Engineering and Consulting, Inc., and Ninyo & Moore Geotechnical & Environmental Sciences Consultants, to provide professional on-call material testing, special inspection, and geotechnical services for Green Build and Capital Improvement projects. These agreements commenced in 2008 and will expire on December 31, 2011. Because of the large on-going airport construction program, the need for these material testing, special inspection, and geotechnical services will continue. This request is to extend the term of each of these agreements by one year to continue to provide services to support Green Build and other Capital Improvement projects.

Each agreement has a maximum on-call capacity of \$3,500,000. Because approximately 37% of the total funding for these agreements remains, no additional funds are requested for the extended term of these agreements.

Fiscal Impact:

Funds for the On-Call Material Testing, Special Inspection, and Geotechnical Services Contract will be provided from individual capital improvement and major maintenance projects included in the respective programs, which are expected to be utilized predominately during the FY2012 through FY2016.

Adequate funds for the Kleinfelder West Inc., MACTEC Engineering and Consulting, Inc., and Ninyo & Moore Geotechnical & Environmental Sciences Consultants agreements are included within the FY2012-FY2016 Capital Budget and the FY2012 Operating Budget on an as-needed basis. Capital sources of funding will include PFCs, AIP grants, Airport Revenue Bonds, and Airport Cash depending upon the individual project.
