- United Airlines Flight 521, July 24, 2014, 11:37 p.m. (2337L) Written information was provided; a representative was present. <u>Panel Recommendation</u> The Panel voted unanimously to assess no penalty due to a maintenance issue (*issues with the engine attrition liner*).
- jetBlue Airways Flight 20, July 28, 2014 12:07 a.m. (0007L) Written information was provided; a representative was present. <u>Panel Recommendation</u> The Panel voted unanimously to assess a penalty in the amount of \$18,000 (*plane was delayed arriving to San Diego, no local issues*).
