



OVERALL PROGRAM SCOPE















Recommendation:

Adopt Resolution No. 2023-0065, approving and authorizing the President/CEO to execute Other Transaction Agreement (OTA Number 70T04023T7672N007) with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security – Transportation Security Administration.

Background/Justification:

As part of the Board approved New Terminal 1 project, Project No. 413001, New T1 Terminal and Roadways, is currently in construction and includes a baggage handling system that requires installation of Explosion Detection System (EDS) equipment provided by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA).

Congress authorizes TSA to make grants to airports to help strengthen the nation's critical infrastructure against risks associated with potential terrorist attacks. TSA utilizes letters of intent and other transaction agreements as funding instruments to reimburse airport sponsors for eligible aviation security projects. TSA distributes funds to airports to assist in infrastructure improvements to enhance the ability of airports to install baggage conveyer systems related to aviation security, and deploy EDS equipment behind ticket counters, in the baggage sorting area, or in line with the baggage handling system.

Execution of the Other Transaction Agreement will allow reimbursement of allowable and allocable costs pertaining to the installation of the EDS equipment in the amount of \$3,164,776.22.

Fiscal Impact:

The baggage handling system and equipment are included in the New T1 Terminal and Roadways Budget, Project No. 413001. The \$3.16 million of OTA funding provides a \$1.16 million improvement to the Authority's plan of finance, which assumed \$2 million of funding.

WHEREAS, as part of the Board approved New Terminal 1 project, Project No. 413001, New T1 Terminal and Roadways, is currently in construction and includes a baggage handling system that requires installation of Explosion Detection System (EDS) equipment provided by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA); and

WHEREAS, Congress authorizes TSA to make grants to airports to help strengthen the nation's critical infrastructure against risks associated with potential terrorist attacks.
