THE WAIVERS AND WAIVER SYSTEM CONTAINED IN THE U.S. COMMERCIAL HUMAN SPACE FLIGHT REGULATIONS

An important aspect of the regulations for Human Space Flight Requirements for Crew and Space Flight Participants is the waiver system they contain. The system requires the operator, crew members, and space flight participants (SFP) to hold harmless and indemnify the US and its entities for loss or damage arising from licensed or permitted activities. In exchange, the operator must provide the SFP with risk information before receiving compensation.
