Award a Contract to Atlas Development, to Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase A, Commuter Terminal and Terminal One, at San Diego International Airport

Recommendation:

Adopt Resolution No. 2012-0050, awarding a contract to Atlas Development, in the amount of \$715,503.54, for Project No. 104122A, Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase A, Commuter Terminal and Terminal One, at San Diego International Airport.

Background/Justification:

As the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority ("Authority") is moving from a single master concessionaire to a multiple-prime management approach, Project No. 104122, Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, will demolish and rebuild concession shells, upgrade utilities and utility monitoring systems, redesign and rebuild neutral piers and sign bands, and perform tenant improvement design review and construction inspections at all proposed concession spaces in the Commuter Terminal ("CT"), Terminal One ("T1"), and existing Terminal Two West ("T2W").

To avoid loss of revenue and negative impact to customer service, the construction of Project No. 104122 has been divided into two separate contracts as follows:

- 1. 104122A- Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase A, CT and T1
- 104122B- Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase B, CT, T1, and T2W existing

Project No. 104122A, Phase A, provides for the construction of two new retail concession shells in the CT and the remodeling of three concessions in T1 (two retail, and one food and beverage).

This project was solicited for bids on February 24, 2012, and sealed bids were opened on April 5, 2012. The following bids were received: (See Attachment A).

Engineer's Estimate is \$678,309.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF THE COUNTY REGIONAL **AIRPORT** SAN DIEGO **AUTHORITY, AWARDING A CONTRACT TO ATLAS** DEVELOPMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$715,503.54 104122A. REFURBISH FOR PROJECT NO. CONCESSIONS SUPPORT INFRASTRUCTURE, PHASE A, COMMUTER TERMINAL AND TERMINAL ONE, AT SAN DIEGO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority ("Authority") is moving from a single master concessionaire to a multiple prime management approach in December, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Project No. 104122 will demolish and rebuild concession shells and upgrade utilities and utility monitoring systems, redesign and rebuild neutral piers and sign bands, and perform tenant improvement design review and construction inspections at all proposed concession spaces in the Commuter Terminal ("CT"), Terminal One ("T1"), and existing Terminal Two West ("T2W"); and

WHEREAS, to avoid loss of revenue and customer service, the construction of Project No. 104122 has been divided into two separate contracts; Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Project No. 104122A, Phase A, CT and T1 and Project No. 104122B, Phase B, CT, T1, and existing T2W; and

WHEREAS, Project No. 104122A, Phase A, provides for the construction of two new retail concession shells in the CT, and remodeling of three concessions in T1 (two retail, and one food and beverage); and

WHEREAS, the Authority issued a Bid Solicitation Package for Project No. 104122A, Phase A, on February 24, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2012, the Authority opened Sealed Bids received in response to the Bid Solicitation Package; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bidder, Atlas Development, submitted a bid of \$715,503.54 and the Authority's staff has duly considered the bid, and has determined Atlas Development is responsible, and that its bid is responsive in all material respects; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority Board ("Board") believes that it is in the best interest of the Authority and the public that it serves, for the Board to award Atlas Development the contract for Project No. 104122A, Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase A, Commuter Terminal and Terminal One, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Bid Solicitation Package.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby awards a contract to Atlas Development in the amount of \$715,503.54 for Project 104122A, Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase A, Commuter Terminal and Terminal One, upon the terms and conditions set forth on the Bid Solicitation Package; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Authority's President/CEO or designee is hereby authorized to execute and deliver such contract to Atlas development; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Authority and its officers, employees, and agents are hereby authorized, and directed to do and perform such acts as may be necessary or appropriate in order to effectuate fully the foregoing resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board FINDS that this Board action is for a project determined not to have a significant effect on the environment (Section 15301, Existing Facilities – Class 1) and a categorical exemption was prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act; and that this project is not a "development" as defined by the California Coastal Act. Pub. Res. Code Section 30106.
