


Update on the San Diego International Airport (SDIA)

Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Services







# City of San Diego Fire Fighters City of San Diego Fire Fighters staff the SDIA ARFF station. • 24 fire fighters are assigned to the ARFF station. Each is assigned to an 8-person squad, and each squad works a 24-hour shift on every third day. As many as 24 additional City Fire Fighters are ARFF certified and they also provide ARFF response at SDIA

#### **SDIA ARFF Station**

- Owned by the Authority
- Communications room, training room, truck bays, kitchen/dining, sleeping quarters and exercise room.
- FAA Control Tower emergency phone links directly into the station P A system



## **ARFF Vehicles**

- Authority owns all four ARFF vehicles
- Specially designed for aircraft response
- FAA regulations specify the number of ARFF vehicles at each airport - based on aircraft size and number of operations
- 80% of ARFF vehicle purchase is paid for with FAA funds

### **ARFF** Responsibilities

- Aircraft Alerts
- Fuel Spills
- Response Tests
- Participation in Exercises
