Authority Program Management History

- 1998 to 2003
 - Port Staff Augmentation Program Began in 1998
 - 25% Port Staff to 75% Program Management Staff (Ratio of 3 to 1)
 - Single Program Management Company
 - Providing Diversified and Talented Staff Assisting With:
 - Capital Improvement Program Management
 - Program Controls and Reporting Systems
 - Planning, Design, Construction, and Project Closeout Oversight
 - Assisting in Contract Procurement
 - Providing Training and Knowledge Transference
 - Ability to Choose the Best Talent

• 2003 to 2012

- Continued Staff Augmentation Program
- Hiring The Key Staff To Maintain Continuity and Reduce Cost (Hired 11 staff)
- 50% Authority Staff to 50% Program Management Staff (ratio 1 to 1)

• 2012 Forward

- May 2012 Board Approved The Selection of 3 Program Management Firms
- Replace Single Firm Concept with Multiple Firms (3)
- Multiple Firms will Provide Competition

 - Maximize the Utilization of DBE,SBE,SDVOSB, and Local Participation
 - Ability to Choose the Best Talent

TOTAL PROGRAM BUDGET - \$688M




Projected Program Management Requirements

Program Management Staffing

- Current Staffing and Mix Participation
 - The Staffing Mix 59 Authority and 58 Program Management Staff
 - 50% Authority Staff to 50% Program Management Staff (ratio 1 to 1)
 - 3 Prime Companies and 7 Sub-Consultant
 - 75.82% of Small Business Enterprise Participation
 - 14.26% of Disadvantage Business Enterprise Participation
 - 69.71% of Local Business Enterprise Participation
 - 96% of Staff are San Diego Residents

Program Management Staffing:

 - 29 Authority Staff
 - 42 Program Management staff
 - 6 Program Managers, 5 Project managers, 6 Architects, 2 Engineers, 2
 Construction Managers, 5 Inspectors, 12 Project Controls, 3 Administrators.
