### Subject:

Award a Contract to PCL Construction Services, Inc., to Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase B, Commuter Terminal, Terminal 1, and Terminal 2 West at San Diego International Airport

### **Recommendation:**

Adopt Resolution No. 2012-0131, awarding a contract to PCL Construction Services, Inc., in the amount of \$7,925,819, for Project No. 104122, Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase B, Commuter Terminal, Terminal 1, and Terminal 2 West at San Diego International Airport.

### **Background/Justification:**

The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority ("Authority") is moving from a single master concessionaire to multiple-prime management. Project No. 104122, Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, will demolish and rebuild concession shells, upgrade utilities and utility monitoring systems, redesign and rebuild neutral piers and sign bands, and perform tenant improvement design review and construction inspections at all proposed concession spaces in the Commuter Terminal ("CT"), Terminal 1 ("T1"), and existing Terminal 2 West ("T2W").

To avoid a loss of revenue and negative impacts to customer service, the construction of Project No. 104122 has been divided into two separate contracts as follows:

- 1. 104122 Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase A, CT and T1
- 2. 104122 Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase B, CT, T1, and existing T2W

Contract 2, provides for the refurbishment of shell spaces at the CT, T1, and T2W.

This project was solicited for bids on August 7, 2012, and sealed bids were opened on September 20, 2012. The following bids were received: (See Attachment A).

The Engineer's Original Estimate was \$6,300,000 (See Attachment A). Subsequent to the advertisement, an addendum was issued on September 5, 2012 to reflect City of San Diego plan check charges and constructability review comments. Construction schedule changes were also issued in an addendum to further support the Concessions Development Program, on September 26, 2012. The Engineer's estimate was updated to \$7,200,000 on September 26, 2012.

### **Fiscal Impact:**

Adequate funds for the contract with PCL Construction Services, Inc., are included within the FY2013 – FY2017 Capital Budget in the Project No. 104122 – Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure. Sources of funding for this project include Airport Revenue Bonds.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY, AWARDING A CONTRACT TO PCL CONSTRUCTION SERVICES. INC.. IN AMOUNT OF \$7,925,819, FOR PROJECT NO. 104122, REFURBISH CONCESSIONS SUPPORT INFRASTRUCTURE. PHASE B, COMMUTER TERMINAL, TERMINAL 1, AND TERMINAL 2 WEST AT SAN DIEGO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority ("Authority") is moving from a single master concessionaire to multiple prime management in December 2012; and

WHEREAS, Project No. 104122 will demolish and rebuild concession shells, upgrade utilities and utility monitoring systems, redesign and rebuild neutral piers and sign bands, and perform tenant improvement design review and construction inspections at all proposed concession spaces in the Commuter Terminal ("CT"), Terminal 1 ("T1"), and existing Terminal 2 West ("T2W"); and

WHEREAS, to avoid a loss of revenue and negative impacts to customer service, the construction of Project No. 104122 has been divided into two separate contracts: Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Project No. 104122, Phase A ("104122A"), CT and T1 and Project No. 104122, Phase B ("104122B"), CT, T1, and existing T2W; and

WHEREAS, Project No. 104122B provides for the refurbishment of shell spaces at the CT, T1, and T2W; and

WHEREAS, the Authority issued a Bid Solicitation Package for this Project on August 7, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2012, the Authority opened sealed bids received in response to the Bid Solicitation Package; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bidder, PCL Construction Services, Inc., submitted a bid of \$7,925,819 and the Authority's staff has duly considered the bid, and has determined PCL Construction Services, Inc., is responsible and that its bid is responsive in all material respects; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority Board ("Board") believes that it is in the best interest of the Authority and the public that it serves, for the Board to award PCL Construction Services, Inc., the contract for Project No. 104122B, Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase B, Commuter Terminal, Terminal1, and Terminal 2 West, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Bid Solicitation Package.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby awards a contract to PCL Construction Services, Inc., in the amount of \$7,925,819, for Project 104122, Refurbish Concessions Support Infrastructure, Phase B, Commuter Terminal, Terminal 1, and Terminal 2 West, upon the terms and conditions set forth on the Bid Solicitation Package; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Authority's President/CEO or designee is hereby AUTHORIZED to execute and deliver such contract to PCL Construction Services, Inc.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Authority and its officers, employees, and agents are hereby authorized, and directed to do and perform such acts as may be necessary or appropriate in order to effectuate fully the foregoing resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board FINDS that this Board action is for a project determined not to have a significant effect on the environment (§15301, Existing Facilities – Class 1) and a categorical exemption was prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act; and that this project is not a "development" as defined by the California Coastal Act. Pub. Res. Code §30106.
