Pursuant to California Public Utilities Code §§ 21670-21679.5, the Airport Land Use Commission ("Commission") is responsible for coordinating the airport planning of public agencies within San Diego County. The Commission has the legal responsibility to formulate airport land use compatibility plans ("ALUCPs") that will (a) provide for the orderly growth of each public airport and the areas surrounding the airport within the County and (b) safeguard the general welfare of the inhabitants within the vicinity of each airport and the public in general. Pursuant to §21670.3, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority serves as the Commission.

This Agenda contains a brief general description of each item to be considered. The indication of a recommended action does not indicate what action (if any) may be taken. *Please note that agenda items may be taken out of order.* If comments are made to the Commission without prior notice or are not listed on the Agenda, no specific answers or responses should be expected at this meeting pursuant to State law.

Staff Reports and documentation relating to each item of business on the Agenda are on file in Corporate & Information Governance and are available for public inspection.

NOTE: Pursuant to Authority Code Section 2.15, all Lobbyists shall register as an Authority Lobbyist with the Authority Clerk within ten (10) days of qualifying as a lobbyist. A qualifying lobbyist is any individual who receives \$100 or more in any calendar month to lobby any Commission Member or employee of the Authority for the purpose of influencing any action of the Authority. Policy for Public Participation in Board, Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC), and Committee Meetings (Public Comment)

- 1) Persons wishing to address the Board, ALUC, and Committees shall complete a "Request to Speak" form prior to the initiation of the portion of the agenda containing the item to be addressed (e.g., Public Comment and General Items). Failure to complete a form shall not preclude testimony, if permission to address the Board is granted by the Chair.
- 2) The Public Comment Section at the beginning of the agenda is limited to eighteen (18) minutes and is reserved for persons wishing to address the Board, ALUC, and Committees on any matter for which another opportunity to speak is not provided on the Agenda, and on matters that are within the jurisdiction of the Board. A second Public Comment period is reserved for general public comment later in the meeting for those who could not be heard during the first Public Comment period.
- 3) Persons wishing to speak on specific items listed on the agenda will be afforded an opportunity to speak during the presentation of individual items. Persons wishing to speak on specific items should reserve their comments until the specific item is taken up by the Board, ALUC and Committees. Public comment on specific items is limited to twenty (20) minutes ten (10) minutes for those in favor and ten (10) minutes for those in opposition of an item. Each individual speaker will be allowed three (3) minutes, and applicants and groups will be allowed five (5) minutes.
- 4) If many persons have indicated a desire to address the Board, ALUC and Committees on the same issue, then the Chair may suggest that these persons consolidate their respective testimonies. Testimony by members of the public on any item shall be limited to **three (3) minutes per individual speaker and five (5) minutes for applicants, groups and referring jurisdictions.**
- 5) Pursuant to Authority Policy 1.33 (8), recognized groups must register with the Authority Clerk prior to the meeting.
- 6) After a public hearing or the public comment portion of the meeting has been closed, no person shall address the Board, ALUC, and Committees without first obtaining permission to do so.

Report of Land Use Actions Determined to be Consistent with Airport Land Use Compatibility Plans (ALUCPs)

Meeting Date: March 19, 2015

Pursuant to Authority Policy 8.30, and acting in its delegated capacity as the Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) for San Diego County, Authority staff has determined that the following land use actions are consistent with their respective ALUCPs:

Gillespie Field ALUCP

General Plan Land Use Designation Amendment and Zone Reclassification from Park/Open Space to General Commercial Use at 10335 Mission Gorge Road, City of Santee

Deemed Complete & Consistent on March 2, 2015

<u>Description of Project</u>: The proposed project involves a land use designation amendment to the City General Plan and a zone reclassification for a property from Park/Open Space to General Commercial Use with no construction proposed.

<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project is located outside the 60 dB CNEL noise contour. The ALUCP identifies all uses located outside the 60 dB CNEL noise contour as compatible with airport uses.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: The proposed project is in compliance with FAA airspace protection surfaces because it does not involve any physical construction.

<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project is located within Safety Zones 2 and 4. The ALUCP identifies general commercial uses located within Safety Zones 2 and 4 as conditionally compatible with airport uses, subject to various ALUCP intensity limitations by use type which will restrict any potential, future development of the property beyond the proposed municipal land use designation and zone classification. The current project does not involve any construction.

<u>Overflight Notification</u>: The proposed project is located within the overflight notification area, but does not contain any new residential uses which would require overflight notification.
