Pursuant to California Public Utilities Code §§ 21670-21679.5, the Airport Land Use Commission ("Commission") is responsible for coordinating the airport planning of public agencies within San Diego County. The Commission has the legal responsibility to formulate airport land use compatibility plans ("ALUCPs") that will (a) provide for the orderly growth of each public airport and the areas surrounding the airport within the County and (b) safeguard the general welfare of the inhabitants within the vicinity of each airport and the public in general. Pursuant to §21670.3, the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority serves as the Commission.

This Agenda contains a brief general description of each item to be considered. The indication of a recommended action does not indicate what action (if any) may be taken. *Please note that agenda items may be taken out of order.* If comments are made to the Commission without prior notice or are not listed on the Agenda, no specific answers or responses should be expected at this meeting pursuant to State law.

Staff Reports and documentation relating to each item of business on the Agenda are on file in the Board Services/Authority Clerk Department and are available for public inspection.

**NOTE:** Pursuant to Authority Code Section 2.15, all Lobbyists shall register as an Authority Lobbyist with the Authority Clerk within ten (10) days of qualifying as a lobbyist. ### Policy for Public Participation in Board, Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC), and Committee Meetings (Public Comment)

- 1) Persons wishing to address the Board, ALUC, and Committees shall complete a "Request to Speak" form prior to the initiation of the portion of the agenda containing the item to be addressed (e.g., Public Comment and General Items). Failure to complete a form shall not preclude testimony, if permission to address the Board is granted by the Chair.
- 2) The Public Comment Section at the beginning of the agenda is limited to eighteen (18) minutes and is reserved for persons wishing to address the Board, ALUC, and Committees on any matter for which another opportunity to speak is not provided on the Agenda, and on matters that are within the jurisdiction of the Board. A second Public Comment period is reserved for general public comment later in the meeting for those who could not be heard during the first Public Comment period.
- 3) Persons wishing to speak on specific items listed on the agenda will be afforded an opportunity to speak during the presentation of individual items. Persons wishing to speak on specific items should reserve their comments until the specific item is taken up by the Board, ALUC and Committees. Public comment on specific items is limited to twenty (20) minutes ten (10) minutes for those in favor and ten (10) minutes for those in opposition of an item. Each individual speaker will be allowed three (3) minutes, and applicants and groups will be allowed five (5) minutes.
- 4) If many persons have indicated a desire to address the Board, ALUC and Committees on the same issue, then the Chair may suggest that these persons consolidate their respective testimonies.

  Testimony by members of the public on any item shall be limited to **three (3) minutes per individual speaker and five (5) minutes for applicants, groups and referring jurisdictions.**
- 5) Pursuant to Authority Policy 1.33 (8), recognized groups must register with the Authority Clerk prior to the meeting.
- 6) After a public hearing or the public comment portion of the meeting has been closed, no person shall address the Board, ALUC, and Committees without first obtaining permission to do so.

## Report of Determinations of Consistency with Airport Land Use Compatibility Plans

Pursuant to Airport Authority Policy 8.30, and acting in its delegated capacity as the Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) for San Diego County, Airport Authority staff has issued the following consistency determinations per their respective ALUCPs:

#### San Diego International Airport (SDIA) ALUCP

## Construction of 9 Attached Residential Units at 2730-2732 First Avenue, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete & Consistent on November 21, 2018

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project involves the construction of 9 attached residential units.

Noise Contours: The proposed project lies within the 60-65 decibel Community Noise Equivalent Level (dB CNEL) noise exposure contour. The ALUCP identifies residential uses located within the 60-65 dB CNEL noise contour as conditionally compatible with airport uses, provided that the building is sound attenuated to 45 dB CNEL interior noise level. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, the building must be sound attenuated to 45 dB CNEL interior noise level.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: The height of the proposed project structure will be 35 feet above ground level. The proposed project is located outside the SDIA Threshold Siting Surface (TSS). The proposed project is in compliance with the ALUCP airspace protection surfaces because a determination of no hazard to air navigation has been issued by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project is located outside all Safety Zones.

Overflight Notification: The proposed project is located within the overflight notification area. The ALUCP requires that a means of overflight notification be provided for new residential land uses. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, a means of overflight notification shall be provided for each residential unit.

## Construction of 395 Attached Residential Units at 232 West Ash Street, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete & Consistent on November 21, 2018

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project involves the construction of 395 attached residential units.

<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project lies outside the 60 dB CNEL noise exposure contour. The ALUCP identifies all uses located outside the 60 dB CNEL noise contour as compatible with airport uses.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: The height of the proposed project structure will be approximately 408 feet above ground level or approximately 458 feet above mean sea level (MSL). The proposed project is located outside the SDIA TSS. The proposed project would be compatible with the ALUCP airspace protection surfaces, provided that the structure is marked and lighted in accordance with a determination of no hazard to air navigation issued by the FAA and an avigation easement for airspace is recorded with the County Recorder. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, the structure shall be marked and lighted in accordance with FAA procedures and an avigation easement for airspace recorded with the County Recorder.

<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project is located outside all Safety Zones.

<u>Overflight Notification</u>: The proposed project is located within the overflight notification area. The ALUCP requires that a means of overflight notification be provided for new residential land uses. In instances when an avigation easement is required, the overflight notification requirement is satisfied.

## Construction of 405 Attached Residential Units with Leasable Office and Retail Space at 16<sup>th</sup> Street and F Street, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete & Consistent on November 30, 2018

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project involves the construction of 405 attached units with leasable office and retail space to replace a prior project for the same property for 209 attached residential units with leasable commercial space reviewed by the ALUC in 2015.

<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project lies outside the 60 dB CNEL noise exposure contour. The ALUCP identifies all uses located outside the 60 dB CNEL noise contour as compatible with airport uses.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: The height of the proposed project structure will be approximately 365 feet above ground level, which will be approximately 405 feet above MSL. The proposed project is located outside the SDIA TSS. The proposed project would be compatible with the ALUCP airspace protection surfaces, provided that the structure is marked and lighted in accordance with a new determination of no hazard to air navigation issued by the FAA for the new

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project and an avigation easement for airspace is recorded with the County Recorder. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, the structure shall be marked and lighted in accordance with FAA procedures and an avigation easement for airspace recorded with the County Recorder.

Safety Zones: The proposed project is located outside all Safety Zones.

<u>Overflight Notification</u>: The proposed project is located within the overflight notification area. The ALUCP requires that a means of overflight notification be provided for new residential land uses. In instances when an avigation easement is required, the overflight notification requirement is satisfied.

## Construction of 368 Attached Residential Units and Leasable Retail Space at 1509 Broadway, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete & Consistent on December 3, 2018

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project involves the construction of 368 attached residential units and leasable retail space.

<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project lies outside the 60 dB CNEL noise exposure contour. The ALUCP identifies all uses located outside the 60 dB CNEL noise contour as compatible with airport uses.

Airspace Protection Surfaces: The height of the proposed project structure will be approximately 95 feet above ground level or approximately 152 feet above MSL. The proposed project is located outside the SDIA TSS. The proposed project would be compatible with the ALUCP airspace protection surfaces in accordance with a determination of no hazard to air navigation issued by the FAA provided that the construction crane associated with project is marked and lighted in accordance with FAA procedures. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, the construction crane associated with the project shall be marked and lighted in accordance with FAA procedures.

Safety Zones: The proposed project is located outside all Safety Zones.

Overflight Notification: The proposed project is located within the overflight notification area. The ALUCP requires that a means of overflight notification be provided for new residential land uses. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, a means of overflight notification shall be provided for each residential unit.

## Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar and Montgomery-Gibbs Executive Airport ALUCPs

## Rezone of an Existing Indoor Entertainment Facility from Residential to Commercial Use at 6999 Clairement Mesa Boulevard, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete & Consistent on November 21, 2018

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project involves the rezone of a property with an existing indoor entertainment facility from single, detached residential to community commercial land use without additional construction in order to allow for on-premises sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages.

Noise Contours: The proposed project lies within the 60-65 dB CNEL noise exposure contour of MCAS Miramar and outside the 60 dB CNEL noise exposure contour of Montgomery-Gibbs Executive Airport. The ALUCPs identify commercial uses located within the 60-65 dB CNEL noise contour for MCAS Miramar and outside the 60 dB CNEL noise contour for Montgomery-Gibbs Executive Airport as compatible with airport uses.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: No change is proposed in the height of the existing buildings.

<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project is located outside all Safety Zones of each respective ALUCP.

<u>Overflight Notification</u>: The proposed project is located within the overflight notification area, but does not involve any new residential use subject to overflight notification requirements.

#### **Brown Field Municipal Airport ALUCP**

General Plan Amendment and Rezone to Construct 270 Attached Residential Units and Commercial Space at Otay Mesa Road and Caliente Avenue, City of San Diego

Deemed Complete & Consistent on November 30, 2018

<u>Description of Project</u>: The project involves a general plan amendment to allow for residential use under a commercial land use designation otherwise prohibiting residential use and the rezone from commercial to multi-unit residential land use of a vacant property to allow for the construction of 270 attached residential units and commercial space.

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<u>Noise Contours</u>: The proposed project lies outside the 60 dB CNEL noise exposure contour. The ALUCP identifies all uses located outside the 60 dB CNEL noise contour as compatible with airport uses.

<u>Airspace Protection Surfaces</u>: This proposed project does not involve any construction; however, the ultimate construction of structures to be allowed by the project must comply with the ALUCP airspace protection surfaces. Therefore, as a condition of project approval, any future structures shall comply with FAA notification requirements if that construction or alteration meets FAA notice criteria.

<u>Safety Zones</u>: The proposed project is located outside all Safety Zones.

<u>Overflight Notification</u>: The proposed project is located outside the overflight notification area.
