Panel Recommendation:

The Panel voted to assess a penalty in the amount of \$2,000.

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<u>Reason</u>

No response from operator and pilot indication of no concern regarding fine.

4. American Airlines Flight 596; February 13, 2019 @ 11:59 p.m.

Written information was provided; representatives were present. Unanimous decision based on time of departure being after 11:30 p.m.

<u>Panel Recommendation:</u> The Panel voted unanimously to assess no penalty. <u>Reason</u> Operational. Aircraft was overweight due to wind shift requiring Runway 9 vs 27.
