



Pannikin first opened its doors in San Diego in 1968. The shop had a small coffee loaster, which founder Bob Sinclair used to roast high quality coffee beans. Pannikin quickly became known as the only place to get fresh reasted whole bean coffee in San Diego.

Responding to the demand for roasted coffee and tea, Sinclair relocated to a larger space in 1972, and expanded its coffee and tea menu. But in 1997, after more than 30 years in the business, Sinclair decided it was time to move on. When a sale to a large national chain fell through, Shawn and Carol Holder came on board to help Sinclair and see if the business was the right fit for them. Six months later, the Holders were owners of

San Diego's premier coffee business. The Holders proved to be a good team. The couple introduced fresh daily baking to the Pannikin business, starting out by mixing banana bread in a bucket with a paddle! Today, everything except the French pastries are made in-house from scratch, no mixes allowed. The same approach is taken in the kitchen. The tood is hearty, healthy and made
