HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS YEAR'S sustainability report

COMMUNITY

SAN's overall annual economic impact to the region was nearly \$12 billion in 2018.

That's about \$2 billion more than a previous study found in 2013. The growth in economic impact is largely due to the Airport's increase in passenger traffic. In 2012, the Airport accommodated nearly 17.3 million passengers, which grew to over 24 million in 2018.

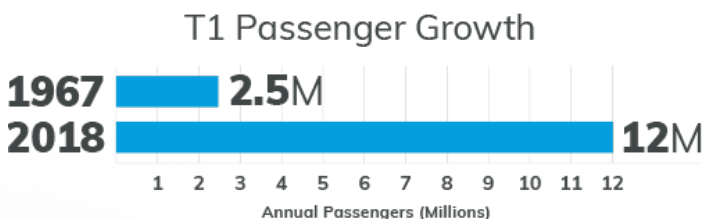

Airport Development Plan Making Strides

Record passenger growth in the past five years has heightened the need to replace Terminal 1. In the year it opened, 1967, the terminal served about 2.5 million passengers. In 2018, it served 12 million.

Record Passenger Growth Reflects Strength of Region as Top Global Destination

SAN served more than 1 million international passengers in 2018 – a first for the airport and a 19 percent increase over 2017 – demonstrating the region’s reputation as a top tourist destination.
