RFPs and Tips For a Small Business to Win a Contract

The three items typically listed in an RFP:

- 1. Scope of services (i.e.: identifying the spaces, the hours of operation, etc.).
- 2. List of proposal submittal requirements.
- 3. Checklist.

Timeline: Differs greatly but roughly have 2-3 months to submit after the RFP goes public.

Making your response stand out: We try to make the documents visually appealing, yet an RFP response is dense by nature. We like to give the reader a break with imagery and negative space. But a lot of RFPs have space limits making it hard to do so.

Wow factor: We love to partner with local brands. Instead of only offering a traditional licensing model to our local restaurant partners, we offer a profit-sharing partnership. The restaurants have their own team members helping to operate the airport location and share in the profits.



Tips For A Strong Joint Venture Partnership

Select your partner wisely – talk to other JV or brand partners of theirs

Keep the communication open (SSP has weekly update calls)

Establish tactics for surviving a pandemic

Implement small gestures to keep morale high

Remember: nothing is more important than compliance!



Compliance in a Joint Venture

What is a Joint Venture/JV?

The code of federal regulations

"49 CFR Part 23" defines a Joint Venture as "an association of an ACDBE firm and one or more other firms to carry out a single, for-profit business enterprise, for which the parties combine their property, capital, efforts, skills and knowledge, and in which the ACDBE is responsible for a distinct, clearly defined portion of the work of the contract and whose shares in the capital contribution, control, management, risks, and profits of the joint venture are commensurate with its ownership interest. Joint venture entities are not certified as ACDBEs."

When an airport reviews or audits the ACDBE participation, the following areas will be reviewed for participation:

- Capital Contribution The joint venture agreement should clearly state how much capital each partner is required to contribute.
- Control The ACDBE participant must have control in proportion to their ownership interest and proportionate control of the governance of the JV.
- Management The ACDBE participant must share in the overall management of the JV.
- Risks Each of the participants in the JV must share in the risks of the business in proportion to their ownership interest.
- **Profits** Each of the participants must also share in the profits and losses in proportion to the ownership interest.



JV Compliance Best Practices

We have specific S. Levy Foods units that we operate with our team of managers. The sales of our units generate our pro rata share of ownership of the JV. It is important to document the work we do. For many of our airports we submit quarterly activity reports with the following information:

- Weekly Managers Calls and Agendas
- Site Visit Forms
- Management Committee Meeting Notes (quarterly)
- Manager Reviews
- Food Trends
- S. Levy Foods Financials (profit and loss)
- Other (highlighting any additional meetings attended at the airport, etc.)
