

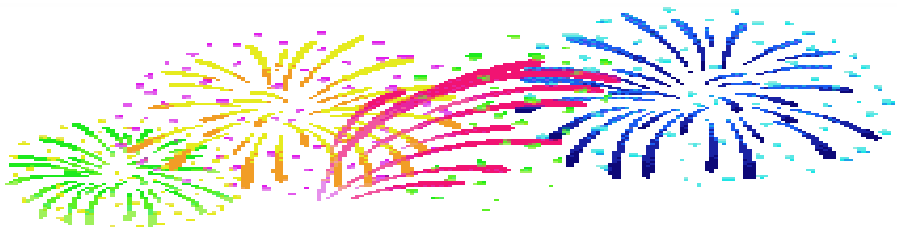

COVID-19 RESPONSE



General Safety Policies and Rules

- Any employee, subcontractor, trade partner, worker or visitor showing symptoms of COVID-19 will be asked to leave the jobsite and return home.
- Face Coverings are required 100% while onsite
- Employees, subcontractors, trade partners, workers and visitors must avoid physical contact with others.
 - All must increase personal space to at least six (6) feet, where possible.
 - All in-person meetings will be limited to ten (10) people.
 - To the extent possible, meetings should be conducted by telephone
- Additional Jobsite cleanings are conducted daily.

SAFETY SHARE: COVID-19 RESPONSE



Sundt COVID-19 Screening Program

- Individuals will be designated by Sundt and subcontractors to conduct temperature scanning for all personnel coming on site at the gate/entry point(s) at the start of each shift.
- Individuals will not be allowed on site, if an elevated temperature 99.6 F or greater, followed by a second confirmed elevated temperature after 15 minutes waiting period.

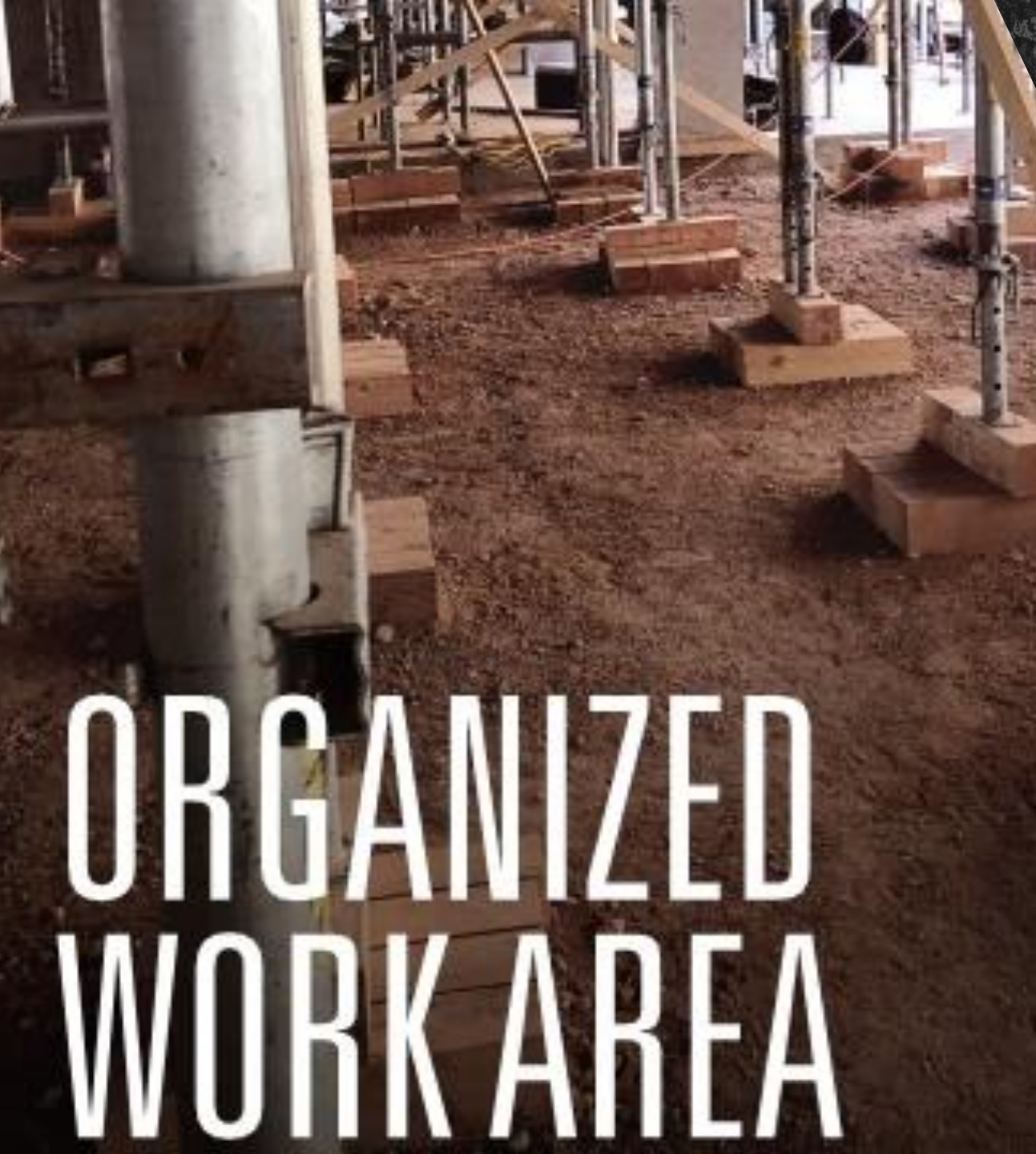

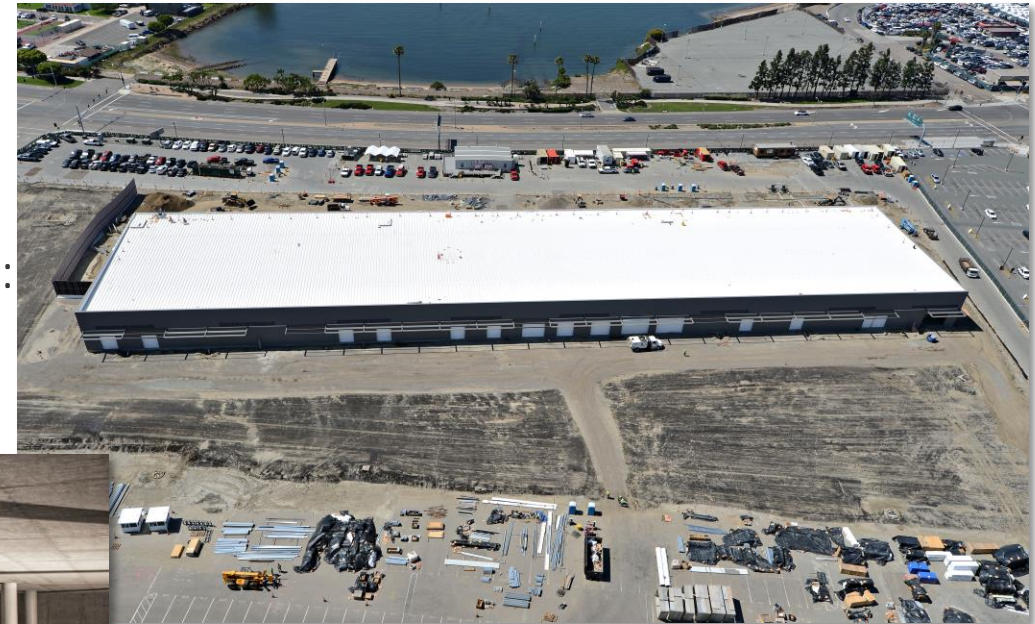

HOW TO WORK WITH SUNDT



Preconstruction Process

- Building of Sub lists
 - Prequal Max Value
 - EMR (Experience Modification Rating)
 - Sometimes Bonding Capacity = when trying to provide opportunities for Local/XBE firms whose max value doesn't meet estimated package value
 - Lists of names taken from our internal database and invitations to Local/XBE concerns in external databases to get prequalified for bid invite
- Invitation to Bid through our estimating system
 - Plans & Specs, Bid Forms and Exhibits can be downloaded
 - Indicate if you are interested in bidding or not = important
- Establish Local/XBE participation commitments for bid packages

- Prequalification required to be renewed *annually*

UPCOMING PROJECTS AND PURSUITS

Air Cargo Facilities

Sundt will be building the new Facilities Management Department campus (to include offices, warehouse, shops, and parking of equipment, fleet vehicles, and staff vehicles), Aircraft fueling operators offices, maintenance facility, and parking facilities for aircraft refueling trucks, Rental Car Center Bus Parking Facility Modifications, and a Consolidated Belly Cargo/Provisioning/Ground Support Equipment Maintenance operations facility.

The project is targeting LEED Gold certification from the United

Administrative Office Buildings

This is an opportunity Sundt is currently pursuing with the San Diego Airport.

Design-Build Delivery Method: A component of the ADP implementation is replacement of the Authority's existing administration building. The location of the existing Airport administration building is in conflict with the proposed Terminal and Roadways and Airside Improvements projects such that these projects cannot be completed until the Authority is moved into the

Airfield pavement

This is an opportunity Sundt is currently pursuing with the San Diego Airport.

The San Diego Airport's capacity for carrying passengers is limited by its single runway. However, the new Taxiway A and other airfield upgrades would improve efficiency and help reduce aircraft taxing times.
