Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) Program

- Federal Program Title 49 CFR Part 23 Participation of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in Airport Concessions
- Airport Improvement Program funding from FAA and car rental/non-car rental concession revenues \$200k+
- Race neutral program and measures: e.g. provide technical assistance, educate/inform on opportunities, and more









Airport Concession Definition

For-profit business:

- 1) Located at an airport (or for which the business activity takes place at an airport) engaged in the sale of goods and/or services to the public under an agreement with airport/concessionaire/owner or lessee of terminal or a business; provides goods and services to those businesses.
- 2) Conducting one or more of following covered activities, even if it doesn't maintain office, store, or business location on airport; as long as activities take place on airport.
 - Examples: Management contracts/subcontracts, web-based electronic business in terminal in which passenger can access at terminal





Concession Examples:

- Food & Beverage
- Retail
- Passenger Services
- Suppliers

- Car Rental Companies
- Vendors to Car Rental Companies(Suppliers, Body Shops, Janitorial, Landscaping, etc.)



California Unified Certification Program (CUCP)

- Participate in statewide Unified Certification Program that provides:
 - "One-Stop-Shop" certification services seeking to participate in U.S. Dept. of Transportation funded contracts
 - Eliminates need for firms to obtain certifications from multiple agencies within the state
- 10 certifying agencies participate in CUCP and follow same certification procedures

ACDBE Certification Process & Timeline

- California Unified Certification Program (CUCP) Certification Portal and ACDBE Directory: https://californiaucp.dbesystem.com
- You may go through interstate certification after approval in your home state
- You may request to apply for "ACDBE" if you are DBE certified already, contact your certifying agency

How To Maintain Your Certification



- Submit Annual Affidavit to your certifying agency
- 5 Year Review
- Submit any business changes to your certifying agency (E.g. business sold, ownership, personal net worth exceeds \$1.32 million)
- Keep you certification and profile up-to-date (Contacts, email, phone, address, website and NAICS codes) on Ca Unified Certification Program Certification Portal and communicate with your certifying agency

• To receive solicitation notifications on Airport opportunities register your firm on Airport vendor portal www.san.org/business.





If awarded a bid, and depending on the scope and scale of the goods and/or services being purchased, the procurement process generally consists of the following steps:

- Providing a signed W9
- Completing a Supplier Setup Form with information about your company
- Providing a copy of your ACDBE certification
- Signing a Master Goods/Services Agreement and applicable statement of work or price sheet
- Utilizing a purchase order for invoicing
- Meeting certain insurance requirements
 (insurance requirements vary depending on the scope and scale of the goods/services)
