

INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS FACILITY FUN FACTS

GENERAL

- 130,000-square-foot facility
- \$229.4 million estimated total project cost
- 200,000+ pounds of sheet metal ductwork
- 4,000+ cubic yards of concrete used, equivalent to 444 truckloads
- 81 foundation piles, reaching 55 feet into the ground
- Four escalators installed
- Three elevators installed
- Certificate of Occupancy received exactly one year from project groundbreaking

ECONOMIC

- \$103 million (87 percent) in contracts to local businesses, surpassing initial commitments
- \$32 million (26 percent) in contracts to small businesses, surpassing initial commitments
- 500,000+ labor hours charged in 366 days
- 3,568 construction workers employed on the project
- 227 sub-contractors involved on the project

SUSTAINABILITY

- Powered by renewable energy through on-campus solar panels
- Carbon offsets via The Good Traveler program reduce greenhouse gas emissions
- Reflective roofing, use of natural light and energy-efficient lighting decreases energy use by 22 percent
- Water-efficient plumbing and ENERGY STAR-rated appliances help decrease water use by 30 percent
- Stormwater is captured on the roof and treated by an on-campus modular wetland system
- Products sourced from at least five manufacturers that disclosed their environmental impact

- Locally (within 100 miles) sourced and recycled content products
- Designed to meet minimum LEED Silver certification

ART

- Carry On was created through a collaboration between artist Walter Hood and 80+ members of the San Diego community and airport staff
 - 225 feet long and made up of 52 glass panels
 - Features 624 photos of unique items that symbolize community, family and culture
- Paths Woven is a suspended artwork by Aaron T. Stephan
 - Made up of 24 maple ladders and one California claro walnut ladder
 - More than four miles of wood laminate and 72 gallons of glue used
 - 500 custom clamps created to fabricate the piece
 - Symbol of swirling ladders represents many individual journeys converging at the airport
