OFF-AIRPORT ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Making It Easier to Get to/from the Airport

The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority is upgrading Grape Street, Palm Street, and Pacific Highway near San Diego International Airport. These improvements will help ease traffic and expand transportation options for residents, businesses, airport travelers, and the surrounding community. Construction is anticipated to take place from summer 2026 through summer 2027, with work carefully coordinated to minimize disruptions.

WHAT TO LOOK FORWARD TO

Once finished, your trip to and from the airport will be smoother and more efficient thanks to:

- **Better roads:** Additional travel lanes, lengthened turn pockets, reconstructed medians and pavement rehabilitation.
- **Enhanced lighting & traffic navigation:** New LED streetlights, upgraded traffic and train signals, new striping and wayfinding signs.
- **Easier for bicyclists and pedestrians:** New separated bike lanes, upgraded curb ramps, new pedestrian push buttons and new crosswalks.
