Alaska Airlines New Route Marks Airline's 50th Destination from SAN

SAN DIEGO, CA — September 3, 2026 – Alaska Airlines has announced it will launch new seasonal nonstop service between San Diego International Airport (SAN) and Loreto International Airport (LTO) in Mexico, marking the airline's 50th nonstop destination from SAN.

The new service will operate twice weekly on Wednesdays and Saturdays from December 19, 2026, through April 28, 2027.
